
1,057,188 international students enrolled at U.S. higher education institutions and were on Optional Practical Training (OPT) in the 2022/23 academic year.



#### U.S. STATES HOSTING INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS, 2022/23




The top states hosting international students were **California**, **New York**, and **Texas**.


