- Note: specialized degree programs such as medicine, law, dentistry, and pharmacy are only available as graduate programs



- October-December

Early action

- October-December
- If admitted, commitment is <u>not</u> required.

Regular deadline


- December-February (or after)
- Deadlines are very important!

Rolling admissions

- Applications are accepted at any time before the start of classes for a particular semester
- Students should apply as early as possible.
