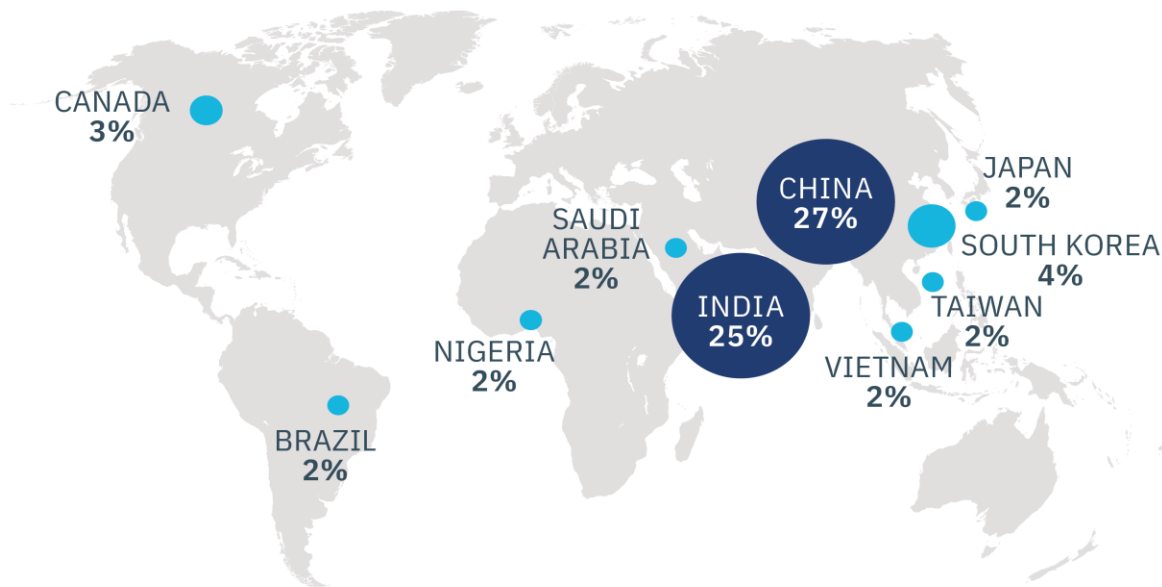

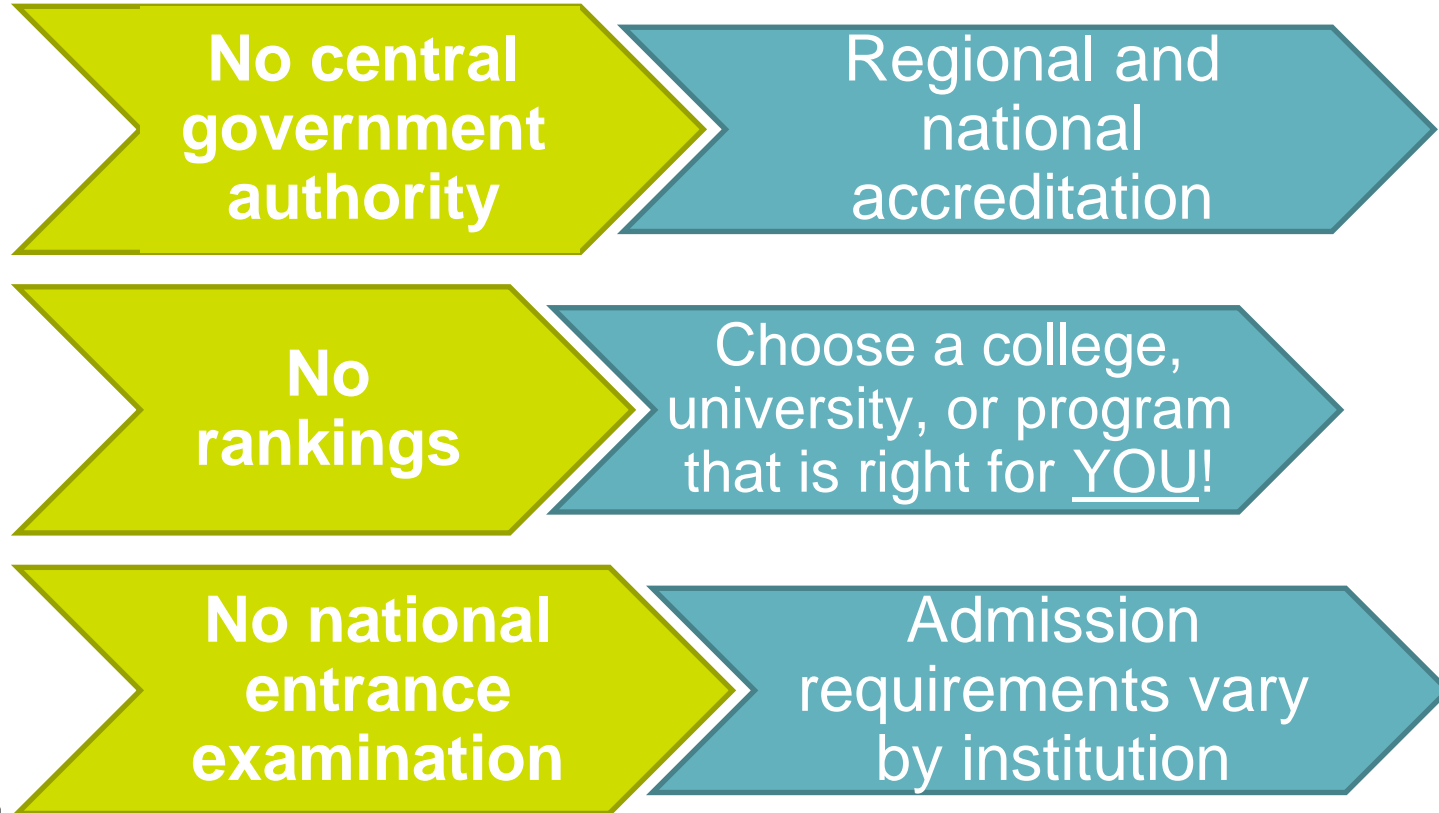

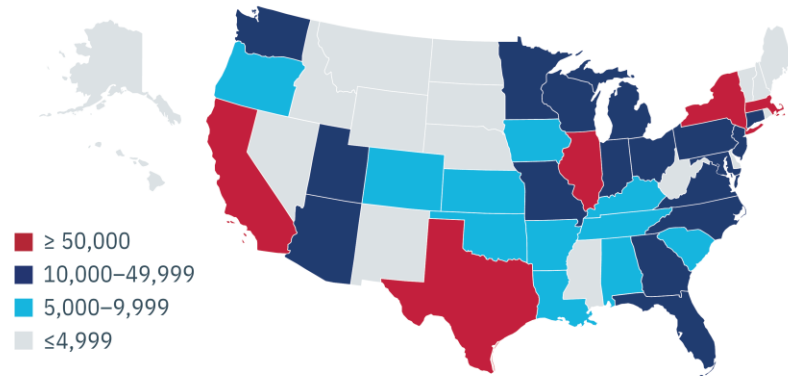

U.S. STATES HOSTING INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS, 2022/23

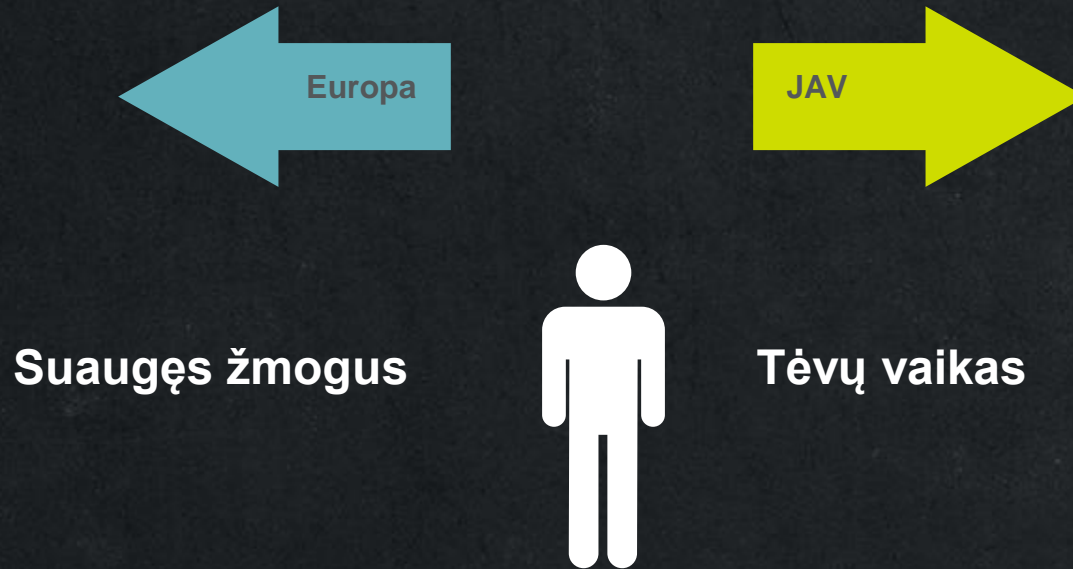


The top states hosting international students were **California, New York, and Texas.**

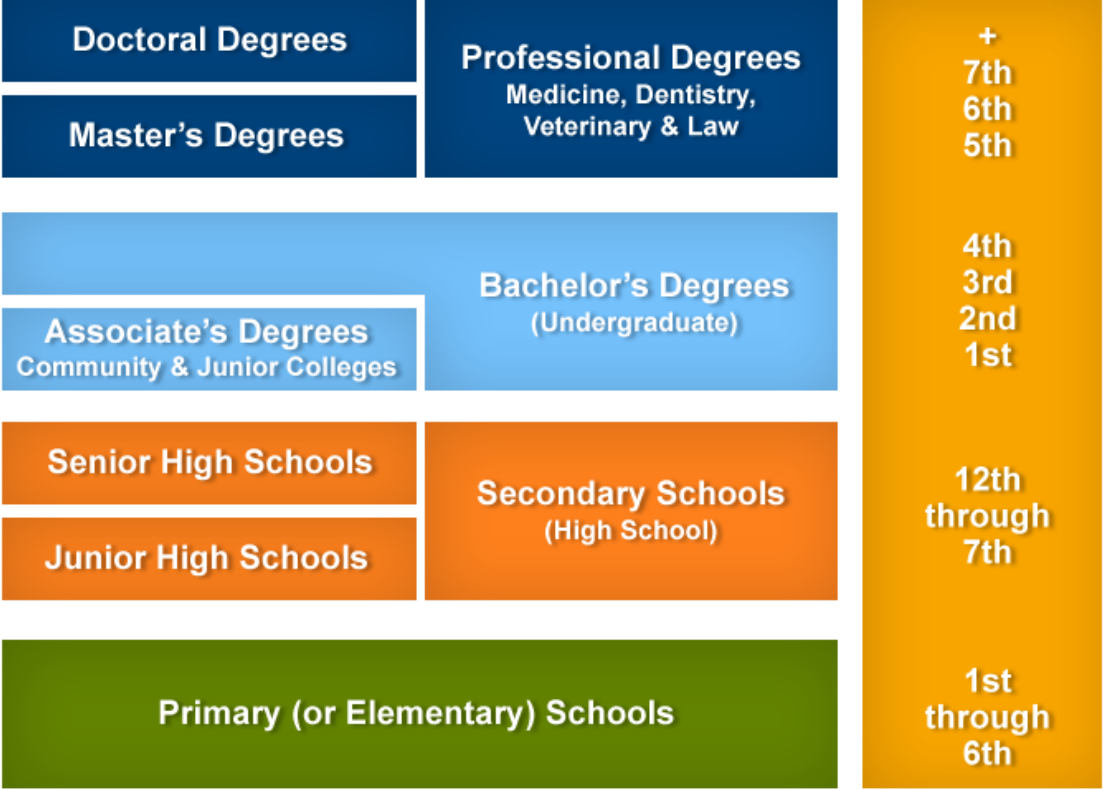

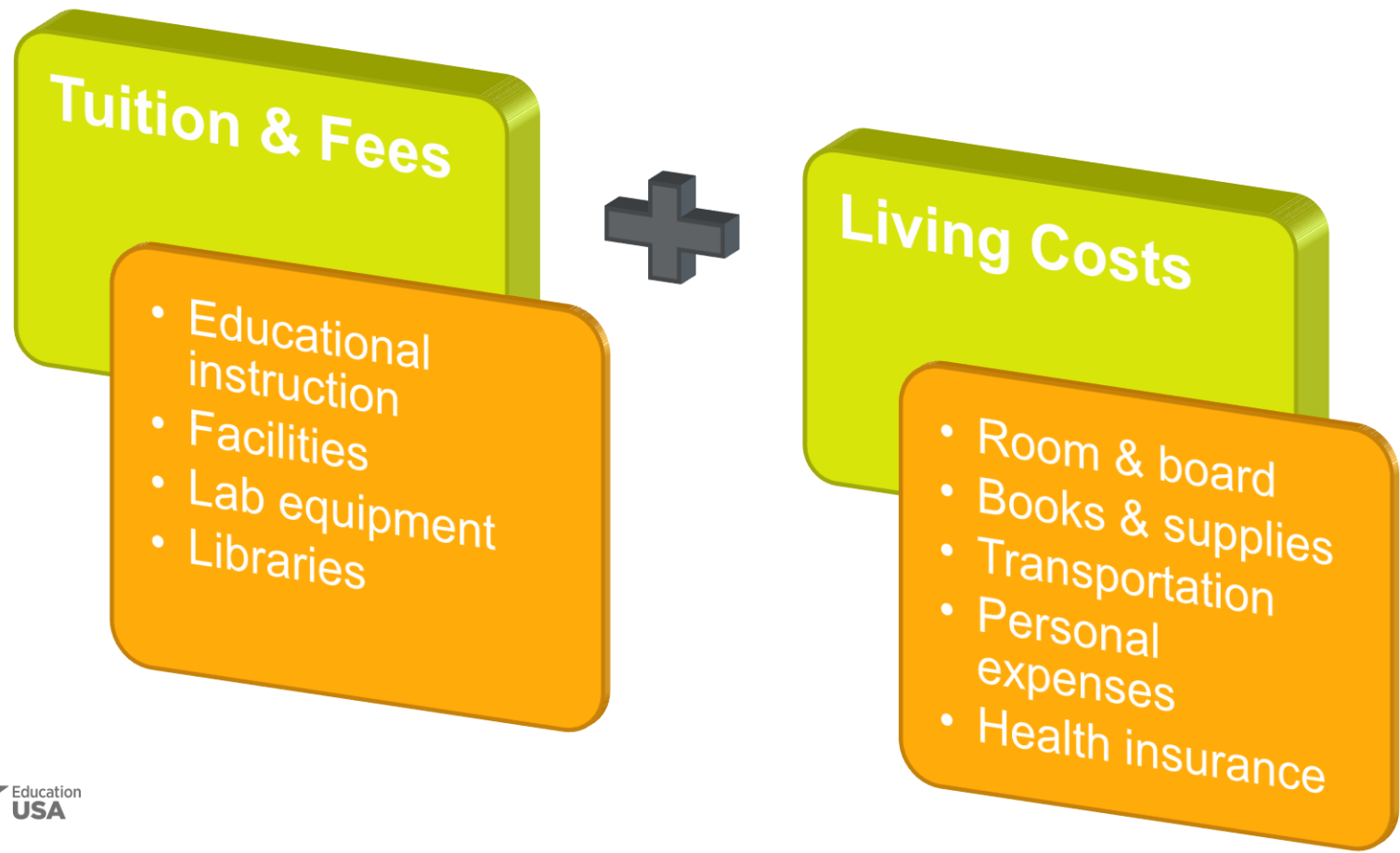
