LEADING PLACES OF ORIGIN OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS, 2023/24

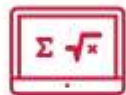


Students from India and China accounted for **54%** of international students.

Liberal Arts Concept



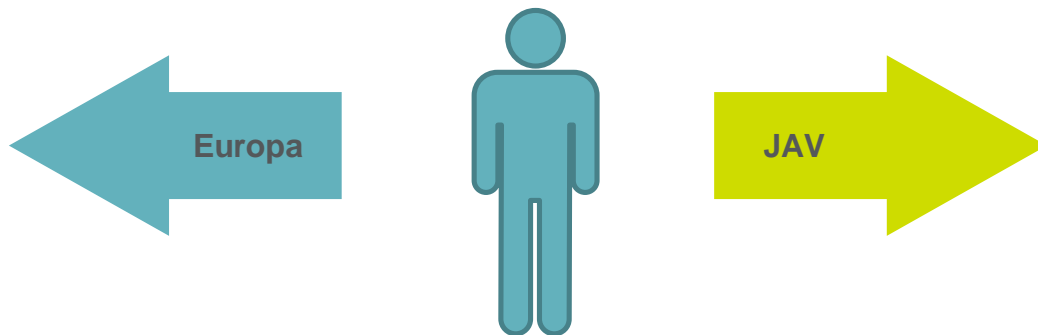
General education (2 years)

- If admitted, commitment is not required.

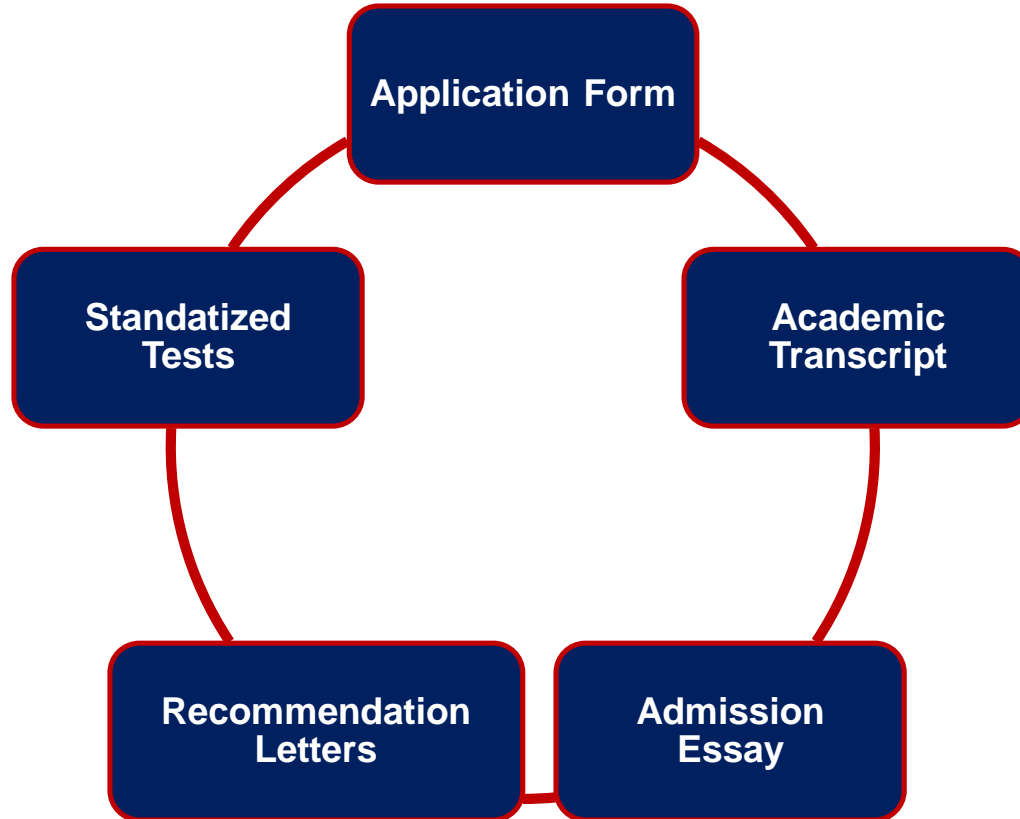
Regular deadline

- Deadlines are very important!

Rolling admissions

- Applications are accepted at any time before the start of classes for a particular semester
- Students should apply as early as possible.
